In 1996, our then Prime Minister Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad envisioned a dynamic and thriving hub that will propel Malaysia into an information and knowledge-based economy. With world-class facilities and infrastructure, and smart homes amidst lush calming greenescapes, the city will be a place where man, nature and technology coexist in harmony.

That was how Cyberjaya, comprising 7,000 hectares of land, came into being.

Of that, 2,890 hectares (about 7,000 acres) was named Cyberjaya Flagship Zone (CFZ). As the name suggests, CFZ is a flagship project for the nation's MSC agenda. The ground-breaking ceremony for CFZ was held on 17 May, 1997.

On the fast track
