A FEW disabled traders are appealing to the Selayang Municipal Council (MPS) to give them the same spot to conduct business during the Thaipusam Festival in Batu Caves on Feb 8.

They met MPS councillor Gopalan Krishnan Rajoo at the MPS building in Bandar Baru Selayang.

Gopalan said he would for-

Arumugam said the group wanted the same spot as it was easy to use the toilet facilities and move about.

"Most of us are in wheelchairs and have been doing business here for more that five years. We hope that the council will look into our plight," he said.
