# Superbiker dies in highway crash

**LONG-DISTANCE EXPEDITION:** Kota Tinggi traffic police chief among six injured

ONE person was killed and six others injured in a collision involving seven superbikers and a sports utility vehicle (SUV) on the New Klang Valley Expressway near Subang Jaya

yesterday afternoon.

The rider who died at the scene was identified as Ishak Jaafar, 53, a Felda settler from Adela, Kota Tinggi in Johor.

His wife, who was riding pillion, was also said to be in critical condition.

It is learnt that a convoy of superbikers from the Cop Bikers club,

based in Kota Tinggi, left Johor at 7am yesterday for a trip to Bukit Kayu Hitam in Kedah.

The convoy, comprising policemen and civilians, was near the Subang Jaya exit when the collision occurred.

The convoy was supposed to stop over for the night in Lumut before continuing their journey today.

Among the injured were Kota Tinggi police traffic and public order chief Assistant Superintendent Kamardin Yusof, 48, who broke the right hand and left shoulder.

His wife, Rohana Fadilah, 43, suffered minor injuries.

Besides Kamardin, it is learnt that one other woman riding

pillion had also been warded.

Petaling Jaya police chief Assistant Commissioner Arjunaidi Mohamed said the injured were sent to Sungai Buloh Hospital.

He said police were still investigating the cause of the accident.

The incident caused a massive traffic jam that stretched up to 10km along the expressway.
