MBSA offers free rides to those seeking medical treatment

THE disabled community in Shah Alam can look forward to free transportation service when seeking medical treatment in the Klang Valley.

The free service was initiated by the Shah Alam City Council (MBSA) because such facilities were limited and hard to come by.

MBSA corporate communications and public relations division chief Shahrin Ahmad said a Toyota Hiace had been modified to accommodate the needs of the disabled

community.

“The vehicle is equipped with a tail lift that can raise a person on a wheelchair with space in the van for two passengers and the driver,” he added.

The vehicle has been fitted with safety features including safety belts to ensure the wheelchairs do not move during the journey.

The van will help transport passengers to Klinik Kesihatan Section 7 and Klinik Kesihatan

Section 19 in Shah Alam, Klinik Kesihatan Bukit Kuda in Klang, University Malaya Medical Centre in Petaling Jaya, Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia Hospital in Cheras, Hospital Tengku Ampuan Rahimah in Klang and Hospital Sungai Buloh in Sungai Buloh.
