## CIVIL SERVICE

**17,000 units** of destitute and dilapidated houses in villages and Orang Asli settlements costing RM350 million

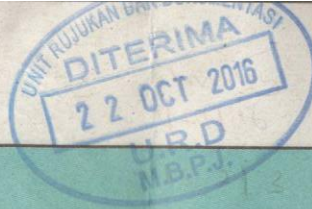

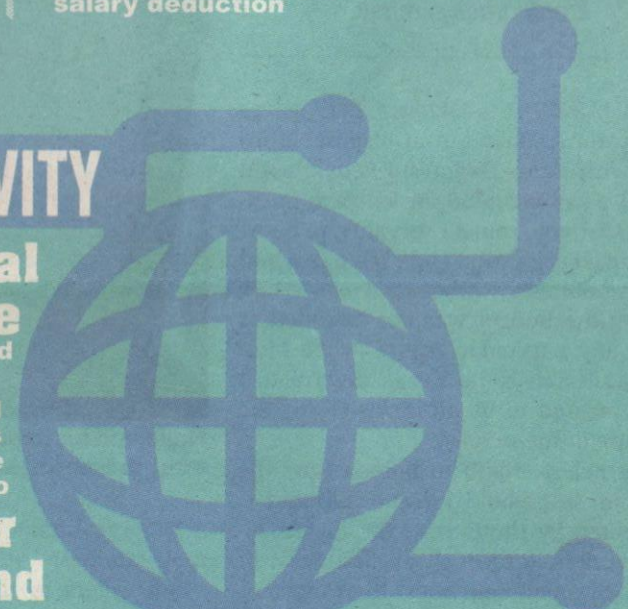
