# Water ponding at bus stop in PJ yet to be rectified 04

WATER ponding next to the Jalan PP Narayanan (formerly Jalan 222) bus stop in Petaling Jaya makes waiting there uncomfortable.

Rajes Mahalingam, who lived nearby, said a pool of stagnant water would form every time it rained.

“It may be because of poor drainage or due to the road structure.

“Whenever it rains, water collects there and does not flow.

“I feel sorry for those at the bus stop as they will get splashed whenever vehicles drive by.

“I’ve reported to Petaling Jaya City Council (MBPJ) several times over the past three years but no action has been taken.

“My neighbour also lodged a complaint about a month ago but there have been no updates,” she said.

When contacted, an MBPJ spokesperson said they were not aware of the issue.

“We will ask the Drainage and Irrigation Department to investigate the cause,” he said. — By NGEOW YI TING
