

1,157 drink drivers arrested last year

KUALA LUMPUR: Police arrested 1,558 individuals for various traffic offences, including for reckless driving and driving under the influence of alcohol, in operations in the federal capital here last year. Kuala Lumpur Traffic Investigation and Enforcement Department deputy head Superintendent Zulkaflī Chek Lah said 1,157 people were arrested for drink-driving and 287 others for driving in a reckless manner. There were also cases of displaying false registration plates, he said here on Saturday night. He also said 235 people were arrested for traffic offences under Op Selamat that began on Jan 1 and ended on Saturday. In the operation conducted in three locations on Saturday night, he said 189 summonses were issued to motorists.
